
**JUDGMENT ENTRY**

This matter came before the Court this 8th day of March, 2002 pursuant to a Complaint filed by Plaintiff seeking forcible entry and detainer and repossession of premises.

The Court notes Plaintiffs Complaint is unsigned. The Court further notes the Complaint was filed February 19 based on a three-day notice dated February 15.

The Court notes, pursuant to the Civil Rules for the calculation of time that three days did not pass between the service of the notice and the filing of the Complaint inasmuch as the 16th, 17th and 18th were weekends and/or holidays.

The Court finds the lack of signature and lack of the three-day notice to be fatally defective and deprive the Court of obtaining any jurisdiction in the matter. Accordingly, the Court orders Plaintiffs Complaint DISMISSED. Costs to Plaintiff.
