Grants support seniors and aging needs

The East Cleveland-based McGregor Foundation, Ohio's only foundation that exclusively funds programs involving seniors and aging needs, has announced its latest grant recipients. They include: Golden Age Centers of Greater Cleveland, which received \$34,480 to help with technology upgrades; \$25,000 to Legal Aid Society of Cleveland for its Pro Bono Elder Law Project; and \$25,000 to the Jennings Center for evaluation of the REACH Project, a long-term care work force development initiative. In all, \$209,000 was distributed to 15 local programs and institutions.
