- May 24, 2-4 p.m. — Clinic in Cuyahoga County for low-income individuals with civil legal issues. West Side Community House, 9300 Lorain Ave., Cleveland.

- May 24, 2-4 p.m. — Clinic in Lorain County for low-income individuals with civil legal issues.

Clients will be helped on a first come, first served basis and should bring all relevant paperwork.
