Jay Winborn was arrested Monday and charged with eight counts of telephone harassment and eight counts of making false alarms for calling police about a crime and leaving a fake name and phone number.

The phone number the calls were coming from was blocked, police said, adding that the latest report was made at 7:15 p.m. Friday

"During each call, it was found that the report of a crime being committed was false," a police

When a phone trap identified Winborn as the caller, he admitted to making the calls but could give police no reason for his actions, police said

Injured firefighter sues car driver

ELYRIA — A Florence Township firefighter who was struck by a motorist at the scene of a crash in 2007 is suing the driver for damages.


Patrick Finnegan, who was 57 at the time of the accident, was directing traffic where a motorcyclist collided with a deer at the corner of Gore Orphanage Road and state Route 113 in Henrietta Township and was struck by Donald Bechtel, who was 88 at the time, of Birmingham.

Bechtel, who was heading westbound on state Route 113, told a state trooper he did not see Finnegan as he swerved to avoid other firefighters working there.

Finnegan was taken to MetroHealth Medical Center in Cleveland where he underwent surgery to repair an extensive leg injury, according to a hospital spokeswoman

The lawsuit, filed Tuesday, alleges that Bechtel was negligent and underinsured to cover all the costs associated with the accident. The suit seeks a judgment in excess of \$100,000.
