U.S. Attorney General Eric Holder in Gleveland to introduce \$2 million child defense initiative

CLEVELAND, Ohio - U.S. Attorney General Eric Holder came to Cleveland on Friday to launch an emergency help line designed to assist abused children.

Holder met with U.S. Attorney Steven Dettelbach and Cuyahoga County Executive Ed FitzGerald, both of whom will assist in the implementation of the 2-1-1 community access line, operated by the United Way, to help children exposed to violence.

The program is part of the Justice Department's Defending Childhood initiative.

Holder also participated in a round-table discussion with students and teachers at Martin Luther King Jr. High School, and later addressed a gathering of law enforcement officers and social workers at the school.

In the afternoon, he spoke at the Legal Aid Society of Cleveland's annual awards luncheon, held at the Cleveland Renaissance Hotel.

Holder said the impact of violence on children has reached "national crisis" proportions, and must be addressed proactively with screening, assessing and treating young people, rather than merely arresting, prosecuting and jailing child abusers.

"We know that children who are exposed to violence are more likely to suffer from depression and anxiety, to abuse drugs and alcohol, and to commit acts of violence themselves," Holder said. "But fortunately, we also know intervention and treatment can be highly effective in helping these children heal, grow and thrive."

United Way of Cleveland President Bill Kitson said the 24-hour help line is staffed by people trained to determine if Defending Childhood services can help a child who has been exposed to violence or experienced trauma.

Cleveland's Defending Childhood project is one of four in the country to receive \$2 million grants from the Justice Department. The money will be spent over two years to develop services to identify and treat children who are exposed to violence. The county will work with Rainbow Babies & Children's Hospital, The Cleveland Foundation, and Third Federal Foundation to raise an additional \$2 million for the project.

FitzGerald said he is confident that the county has a full partnership with the federal government to assist in dealing with the wide-ranging problems of youth violence.


"Talk is cheap in politics, but this isn't just rhetoric out of Washington," FitzGerald said.
"It's a passion backed up by the necessary funds from Attorney General Holder."

The project has brought together 150 experts in the county to develop a comprehensive plan to identify children exposed to violence, assess their needs, and provide treatment. Dettelbach is chairing a 75-person governing board responsible for overseeing the collaborative effort.

The Attorney General's National Task Force on Children Exposed to Violence is expected to issue a report later this fall that is being touted as a blueprint for ways to prevent children's exposure to violence, and means of mitigating its effects.
