The Legal Aid Society of Cleveland will host a legal clinic at the Goodrich-Gannett Neighborhood Center (1368 East 55th Street and St. Clair) on June 9, 2007. Volunteer attorneys from **Squire Sanders and Dempsey** will provide **FREE** legal advice for low-income individuals and families. These attorneys will provide brief legal advice and possible referrals concerning **civil issues (not criminal)**. Doors will **open at 9:45 a.m.** and the clinic **ends at 12 noon**.
