



McGregor Foundation continues support for financial literacy among low-income seniors

EAST CLEVELAND, Ohio -- The McGregor Foundation recently awarded \$388,095 to 17 nonprofits aiding vulnerable senior citizens in Northeast Ohio.

Among the grantees is the Cleveland Department of Aging, which for the second consecutive year received \$45,000 from the McGregor Foundation and another \$45,000 from the Cleveland Foundation to provide financial counseling to 500 low-income seniors.

Another grant of \$30,000 went to the Legal Aid Society of Cleveland for its Pro Bono Elder Law Project, which provides legal services to low-income seniors.

McGregor, based in East Cleveland, is the only foundation in Ohio devoted exclusively to senior care. It has distributed more than \$8 million to 300 organizations since it was established in 2002.
