Garfield Blvd.-Turney Rd. businesses hit in series of break-ins Tuesday

Five businesses in Garfield Heights were broken into early yesterday morning on Turney Road and Garfield Boulevard between 2 and 3 a.m.

The Balloon Crew and The Trophy Shop on Garfield Boulevard had broken windows and merchandise missing.

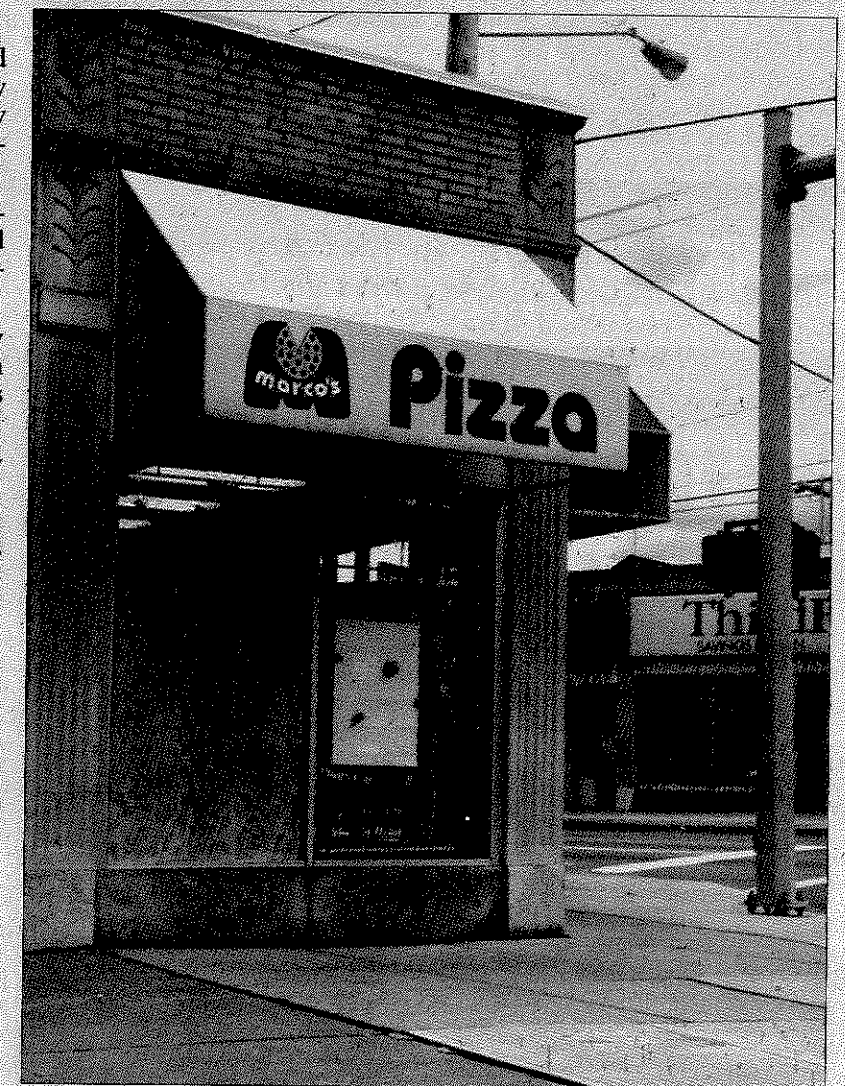
The manager of The Trophy Shop stated that money was taken from her register and trophies were stolen.

The owner of The Balloon Crew said the alarm was never triggered, but a digital camera was missing. She also stated that the business will be adding monitors to all windows, updating the alarm sensitivity and installing security cameras.

Lal's Cleaners, also on Garfield Boulevard, had no merchandise stolen and no alarm was triggered, but the front window to the building was broken. The owner said this was the second time in about three months someone had tried breaking in.

The manager at Marco's Pizza on Turney Road said the alarm system went off and the building had a broken front window, but only \$20 in assorted change had been stolen.

An employee at Garfield Auto Center on Turney Road stated that Garfield Heights High School's surveillance camera recorded a video of a man walking out of the auto center at about 2:20 a.m. Approximately 30 model

cars were stolen out of a front showcase.

Garfield Heights Police and the

Detective Bureau are gathering evidence from the five businesses in the ongoing investigation to discover those responsible.

Longo announces nominations for commission to oversee city's finances

Mayor Thomas J. Longo announced at Monday's meeting of Garfield Heights City Council that he and Council President Frank Wagner have submitted the names of five individuals to fill the three spaces on the commission which will supervise and approve city finances, in accordance with the city's fiscal emergency status set by the State Auditor's Office earlier this month.

The five names that were submitted were Matthew D. Deliberato of Golubski-Deliberato

Budget and Management and a member of the state Treasurer's Office.

Governor Ted Strickland has 30 days from the date that the list was submitted to choose the last three members. He may also choose individuals not on this list, which was submitted on October 22.

At Monday night's meeting, council passed legislation allowing the issuance of \$1,800,000 in bonds to cover the costs of improving city streets, including Transportation Blvd., Antenucci Blvd., E. 131 St. and improve-

Council has until November 14 to appoint a new councilperson for Ward 7. If it does not do so in the allotted time, Mayor Longo will make the appointment. For individuals interested in the position, resumes and letters of intent can be sent to the Clerk of Courts at the Garfield Heights Law Department. All materials must be postmarked by October 31.
