Through our representation, we have found that many charter schools, including the Weems School, have acted irresponsibly in other realms as well, including failing to provide students with the due-process and special-education rights mandated by law.

Unfortunately, parents are often unaware of the academic and financial track record of the charter school they select in their rush to find a viable education alternative for their children. Despite the closing of the Weems School, there are still too many charter schools operating in Ohio with low academic performance, deficient special-education services and questionable financial practices.
