PERMANENT INJUNCTION


This matter came on for further consideration upon Plaintiff's request for a permanent injunction. The Court FINDS that Plaintiff's request for a permanent injunction is well taken.

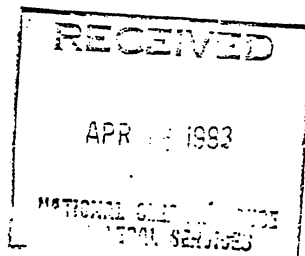
