Brief Advice & Referral Clinics:

Usually held on Saturday mornings or weekday afternoons, these clinics are held at neighborhood community centers and provide low income individuals the opportunity to meet with an attorney to ask questions about legal issues they are facing (civil matters only). The volunteer attorney's time commitment is approximately two hours. Legal Aid staff is present at the clinic to provide mentoring.

Pro Se and Specialty Clinics:

These clinics address the needs of *pro se* litigants with divorce, child support, bankruptcy, or expungement issues. Volunteer attorneys assist individuals with *pro se* pleadings and provide advice about proceeding *pro se*. Clinics are usually held on Saturday mornings or weekday afternoons. The volunteer attorney's time commitment is approximately three hours and Legal Aid staff provides training and mentoring.

Traditional Attorney-Client Match:

Volunteer attorneys provide extended representation to client. Time commitment varies. Referrals are made in various areas of civil practice. Mentoring and support are provided.
