The parties, through counsel, have submitted this matter for decision on whether plaintiff has the right to terminate defendant's tenancy at the end of her lease without "good cause." Plaintiff is subject to certain restrictions as a recipient of Federal Low Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC). 26 U.S.C. §42.

After this matter was submitted for decision, the Internal Revenue Service issued a ruling clarifying this matter. IRS Revenue Rule 2004-82§C. The ruling extends the "good cause" for eviction requirement throughout the 15 year low income housing commitment period. Therefore, plaintiff, at this time, cannot evict defendant.

Plaintiff's complaint seeking eviction and restitution of premises is dismissed and all monies in escrow are released to plaintiff.
