Who can join MetroHealth Care Plus?

- Your income must be at or below 133% of the federal poverty level. This is \$15,282 for a single person
- You must be a U.S. citizen or a legal immigrant who has been in the U.S. for five years or longer
- You must live in Cuyahoga County
- You are 19 to 64 years old
- Vou have no health insurance and you cannot get Medicaid or Medicare

What does the program cover?

Coverage includes:

- Inpatient hospital care
- Doctor visits
- Prescription medications
- Home care services
- Nursing services
- Mental health services
- Alcohol and drug abuse services
- Emergency services, including transportation

- Physical and speech therapies
- Some medical equipment
- Podiatry services (treatment of feet)
- Smoking cessation (quit smoking)
- Weight management clinic services
- Nutrition counseling
- Dental care
