MyCare Ohio is a New Managed Care Program for People who have both **MEDICARE** and **MEDICAID**. If you are one of these people and

If you receive Medicaid services from one of the following programs, you will be part of MyCare Ohio:

Do I have to enroll in MyCare Ohio?	YES
When will I receive information about MyCare Ohio?	Late February
What are my Plan choices?	Buckeye, CareSource, or UnitedHealthcare
I live in <i>Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, or Medina County</i> - when can I select a plan?	March 1, 2014-To select a plan, call the OHIO MEDICAID CONSUMER HOTLINE at 1-800-324-8680
When will my plan start?	May 1, 2014
What happens if I don't choose a plan?	In March, the Ohio Department of Medicaid will select a plan for you and notify you by mail in April.
What if I don't like the Plan assigned to me, can I change?	If you want to change plans, call the <i>OHIO MEDICAID CONSUMER HOTLINE at 1-800-324-8680</i>
If I change, when will my Plan start?	The first day of the following month.
Do I have to stay in MyCare Ohio in order to receive services for both my Medicare and Medicaid?	You have to remain in MyCare Ohio for your Medicaid services, but you can choose whether to enroll for your Medicare services.

NOTE: If you receive services through your local County Board of Developmental Disabilities and have Medicare and Medicaid, contact your Service and Support Administrator for more information. You may be able to voluntarily join MyCare Ohio.
