## JUDGMENT ENTRY

This matter came on to be heard upon the Plaintiffs complaint seeking to evict the Defendant from a federally subsidized housing unit located in Pataskala, Ohio. For the reasons which follow the Court rules that the Plaintiff is not entitled to restitution of the premises.

The Defendant failed to pay her February rent on or before the due date. She did however inform the Plaintifflandlord that she was unable to pay her share of the subsidized rentalamount due to the Bureau of Child Support not forwarding to her child support payments. On February 7, the Defendant was served with a notice toleave the premises and notice of termination of the tenancy due to a failure topay February's rent by February 1, 2006. Prior to the initiation of this action the Defendant made numerous attempts to explain thesituation to the Plaintiff's manager and also to tender rent and late charges to the Plaintiff's manager. The Defendant also tendered rent money for Mach 2006 which was refused by the landlord.
