

This matter came on for trial on the merits this 26th day of February, 1985. A jury of eight persons having been impanelled and sworn the parties presented their evidence. The Court charged the jury and after deliberation it returned a verdict for the Plaintiff in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) compensatory damages and Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) punitive damages. Whereupon the jury was discharged and the Court proceeded to the question of an award of attorney fees; The Court having heard evidence and arguments finds the reasonable value of the services of Plaintiff's attorney to be One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). It is therefore ordered that Plaintiff have judgment against Defendant in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for her damages and that the Plaintiff is awarded the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) attorney fees which is ordered taxed as costs. Defendant to pay costs herein.
