## Supporting Women in the Shelter

The Cleveland Bar Association's Women in Law Section approached Priscilla Franklin, Moriah House - Women and Children's Shelter Director, about providing legal services to women in need. Starting in May 2015 lawyers from all over Cleveland are giving their time to answer legal questions posed from women residing in our Shelter.

Guided by Ann Porath and Mary Beth McConville from Legal Aid, these female lawyers are providing an invaluable resource to our clients.

In their first session in May, they served half the current adult population in the Women and Children's Shelter. The issues and questions they addressed included:

- Eviction
- Family disputes over housing
- How to file a divorce complaint
- Child custody
- Supplemental Security Income application process

"Mostly, we listened," said Rebecca Bennett, Chair CMBA Women in Law Section. "We learned from recent training sessions, much of the help that these individuals need is in navigating the 'systems' in which they are dealing. Imagine having to cut through red tape and navigate government agencies when you don't even have your documents in your possession because you don't currenly have a home. We hope that our continued monthly presence at the Women and Children's Shelter will be of help."

With each session the Women in Law have seen higher participation and more challenging questions. They are pleased to know their services and time are appreciated and needed.
