Pursuant to the mandate of the Court of Appeals for Coshocton County, Ohio, Fifth Appellate District, as filed May 3, 2002, this court has reviewed the evidence from the bench trial held February 15, 2001, and the findings made as a result of that trial, and hereby amends its award of punitive damages payable from the defendants, jointly and severally, to the plaintiffs, to the amount of \$250.00. In so doing, the court has attempted to make a reasoned determination of an amount that fairly punishes these defendants, given their financial circumstances as established at trial, for any malicious activity and that will be adequate to deter any others from similar conduct.

The award of \$250.00 is 298% of the filing fee for a forcible entry and detainer action in this court. Such award will be sufficient to deter not only these defendants, but all others that are similarly situated from engaging in any contemplated "self-help" eviction contrary to statutory regulation. The court finds this award of punitive damages to be sufficient to satisfy both the retributive and deterrent functions of punitive damages as they relate to not only these

defendants but also to all other similarly situated landlords in this county.

In all other respects, the judgment entry of April 27, 2002, is hereby restated and confirmed.
