

## FREE LEGAL HELP

Legal Aid and MetroHealth have partnered to provide free legal services to low income patients through the Community Advocacy Program (CAP) – a medical-legal partnership.

### LEGAL AID CAN HELP WITH:



**Education** Special Education, School Discipline, Student Loan Problems



**Income and Health Benefits** Problems with Ohio Works First (Cash Assistance), Medicaid/Medicare, Food Stamps, SSI and Social Security Disability Benefits, Veterans Benefits



**Housing** Lead Exposure & Other Poor Housing Conditions, Evictions, Foreclosures



**Work and Employment** Record Sealing, Wage Claims, Federal Income Tax Debt, and Unemployment Compensation



**Family** Domestic Violence, Some Divorce, Custody, & Child Support Issues, Wills and Guardianships



**Consumer Issues** Bankruptcies, Public Utility Issues, Debt Problems



**Immigration** Petitions for Immigrants who are Victims of Crime/Domestic Violence, Family Petitions, Naturalization (citizenship), and Detention and Deportation
