For more than a decade, Partners in Justice have led to significant growth in philanthropic and volunteer support. As a result, Legal Aid continues to be the difference between homelessness and home, danger and safety, poverty and security for so many families. When justice is available to all, democracy thrives - and Northeast Ohio becomes safer, healthier, and more equitable.

In 2026, Partners in Justice will do one or more of the following:

- 2) Encourage participation in Legal Aid's major events: **Founders' Day, Jam for Justice, Pro Bono Week**, and the **Annual Meeting**.
- 3) Engage with, recruit for, and raise awareness of *pro bono* opportunities through Legal Aid's **Volunteer Lawyers Program**.
- 4) Participate in **exclusive Partners in Justice programming** like networking events and guest speakers.

These activities are fully supported by Legal Aid's Development and Communications Department. Legal Aid staff will collaborate with you to create an outreach plan, provide marketing materials, draft sample correspondence, and support any additional ideas/efforts.
